## DEAR COLLEAGUES,

Renal denervation is a new catheter based technique to treat severe arterial hypertension. The afferent and efferent renal nerves are interrupted by applying radiofrequency energy to the renal artery wall via an endovascular approach. This technique is a major breakthrough in antihypertensive therapy. The results of the randomized trial were recently reported at the American Heart Association Congress in Chicago.
